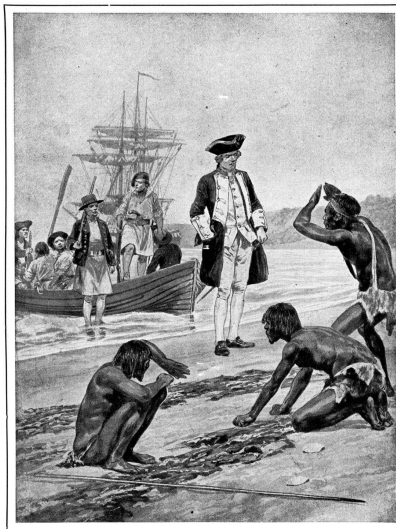

This unit is about the [1]_____ people that live in Australia and the story of the First [2]_____ that sailed to Australia from England. The indigenous people have lived in Australia for many thousands of [3]_____. Some scientists have dated a skeleton found in Lake Mungo to be 40,000 years old. Here, they have also found middens, layered hills of shells, [4]_____ and animal remains. The First Fleet arrived in Australia in 1788, a little over 200 years ago. This fleet of ships brought the first British people to Australia to live.

During the [5]_____ of years that the indigenous people lived in

Australia, they spread across the land. There were many different clans, or groups, of [6]_____ people that lived and moved around Australia. Each clan had a slightly different language and different ways of doing things, depending on the land where they lived and travelled. The indigenous people were full of [7]_____, meaning there were many differences between each small clan. This meant that the indigenous people were [8]_____, because there were many different cultures and customs within the indigenous clans. The [9]_____ peoples were the clans with similar languages who lived in the area of Port Jackson, where the British landed.

Indigenous people look after the land because they believe they are part of the land and the environment. They were [10]_____, which means

they followed food and water from place to place. They learned to live by eating just enough of the local plants ([11]_____) and animals (fauna) that they needed. Each clan, in their own way, looked after their land so that there would always be food. The [12]_____, ways of doing things, was passed down from father to son through stories.

The land in [13]_____ was very dry in many parts, and wet and green in other parts. There were mountains and deserts, with different animals across the land. These animals were very different to any other animals in the world because Australia was a large [14]_____. In many parts of Australia, the weather was very hot, and very dry, so having water was very [15]_____. Much of Australia had only small numbers of indigenous people because it was so hot and dry.
